Finally, it is important to remember that when you work in a virtual environment, you are still working towards achieving real-world goals. For example, to be an effective communicator, you should start small.

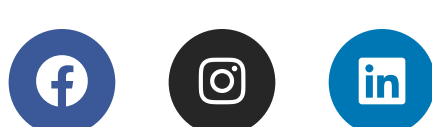
